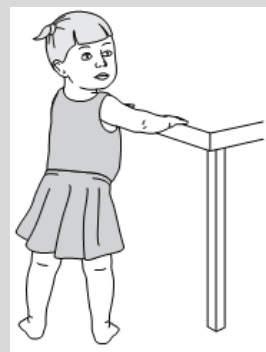

Standing with assistance

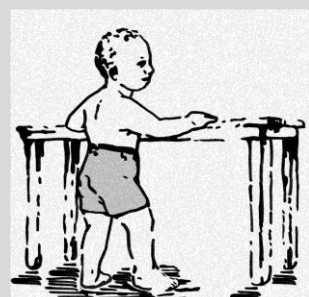

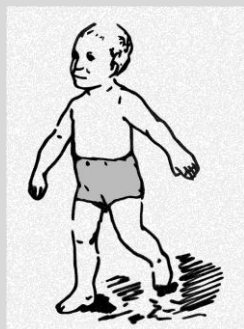
